Reading/Writing

We'll be reading our classroom novels and applying reading strategies like making predictions, summarizing, questioning and making inferences. We will also be participating in literature circles, guided reading and learning centers. Your child is expected to read 30 minutes at home each night. They should read aloud and silently.

Math

In math, we will be dividing, working on multi-step word problems and on fractions. It is imperative that your child practices their multiplication tables at home daily, since it is a skill that should've been mastered in third grade. This skill is very important to have in order to be successful with 4th grade math.

Science

In science, we will continue to learn the scientific method to prepare for the Science Fair which will be taking place in December. We will also be using the Scholastic Super Science magazines.

Social Science

In Social Science we will be learning some Geography skills, working on current events and using our Scholastic Reader magazines. We will also continue to teach and apply CHAMPS and the B.A.R.K school wide behavior expectations.
